ACNA Prayer book – We have received permission to use the new prayer book on a trial basis during Lent. Fr. Michael, who is the Dean of our deanery, gave us the following advice: I bought prayer books, but what I use at the altar is a print out from the PDF. I made a sign-up sheet for members of the congregation and asking them for \$20 for the pew edition and \$35 for the deluxe. I ordered a bunch of extra pew editions just to keep on a bookshelf, but people mostly ordered the deluxe edition. The leather is nice, but more importantly, the print is substantially larger, which is helpful for older people, in case any begin to attend our services. Following the trial use, we will make a decision about whether to continue to use it. New adventures for the new year.
