There is so much of importance going on at St. Mary's this month. Please add the following to your calendars:

- 1.) Live-streaming of services:** This is a way for us to practice evangelism and to spread our love for Christ throughout the world. (really). In order to make this happen more easily, I would ask you to become silent when I come behind the altar because any remarks made lead to hours of editing trying to remove them. Likewise, please remain silent for 10 seconds after the dismissal giving time for the camera to be turned off. Thank you.
- 2.) Daylight Savings Time ends:** Be sure to remember to turn your clocks back one hour when you go to bed this Saturday night. Failure to do so will will cause you to arrive late at church on Sunday.
