Therefore, I have set up the following Outreach products for the rest of the year:

- 1. October:** As we have done the last few years, we have once again been asked to participate in the blanket drive sponsored by a neighborhood church located just across from St. Luke's Church in Springfield. All you need to do is to bring your gently used (or new) blankets to church next Sunday (**Oct. 6**) will deliver them so they might be distributed to those who are in need of them.
- 2. November:** This year, our congregation will once again be participating in the Operation Christmas Child program. Boxes are here and ready to be filled. We await some of the materials, such as the tags and the brochures about what to pack in the box. **November 3** will be the ingathering date for the boxes. One thing that is new this year is that everyone is asked to put \$9 in the box with the gifts to cover the cost of shipping and handling.
- 3. December:** Reverse Advent Calendar. I sent you and email regarding this a few weeks ago, and I will resend it as December gets closer. This involves putting a different food item in a box for each day of Advent, then delivering the box to the local food bank on Christmas Eve. For those who wish to do so, a monetary donation can be made to the church then that money used to buy the food.
